BUILDING A BETTER I-4

NIGHTTIME CLOSURE OF EASTBOUND INTERSTATE 4 (I-4) BETWEEN GORE STREET AND STATE ROAD (S.R.) 408 TO OCCUR SEPTEMBER 6

The Florida Department of Transportation is temporarily closing at night eastbound I-4 between Gore Street and S.R 408. The closure will occur from 12 a.m. to 5 a.m. on September 6. Law enforcement officers will monitor each signaled intersection on the detour route of Garland Avenue between S.R. 408 and Colonial Drive to promote traffic flow. The eastbound I-4 entrance ramp from eastbound S.R. 408 and the eastbound I-4 exit ramp to Amelia Street also will be closed from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. on September 5-6. The eastbound I-4 entrance ramps from Anderson Street and westbound S.R. 408 will remain open. See reverse side of handout for alternate routes when traveling through Central Florida. The closures are necessary for bridge work. Closures are dependent on weather and other conditions.


Traveling eastbound on I-4:

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- Exit eastbound I-4 at Exit 82B onto South Street
- Continue northbound on Garland Avenue
- Enter eastbound I-4 from Garland Avenue just beyond Concord Street

Traveling eastbound on State Road (S.R.) 408:

- Exit eastbound S.R. 408 at Exit 10C
- Keep right and merge onto Lucerne Circle
- Turn right onto Orange Avenue, which becomes Rosalind Avenue
- Continue on Rosalind Avenue, which becomes Magnolia Avenue
- Enter eastbound I-4 from Magnolia Avenue

MOTORISTS USING I-4 HAVE OTHER OPTIONS WHEN TRAVELING THROUGH CENTRAL FLORIDA



- 3 State Road 417 (Central Florida Greeneway)(toll)
- 4 State Road 528 (toll) to State Road 434 to U.S. 17-92
- 5 State Road 528 (toll) to State Road 436 (Semoran Boulevard)
