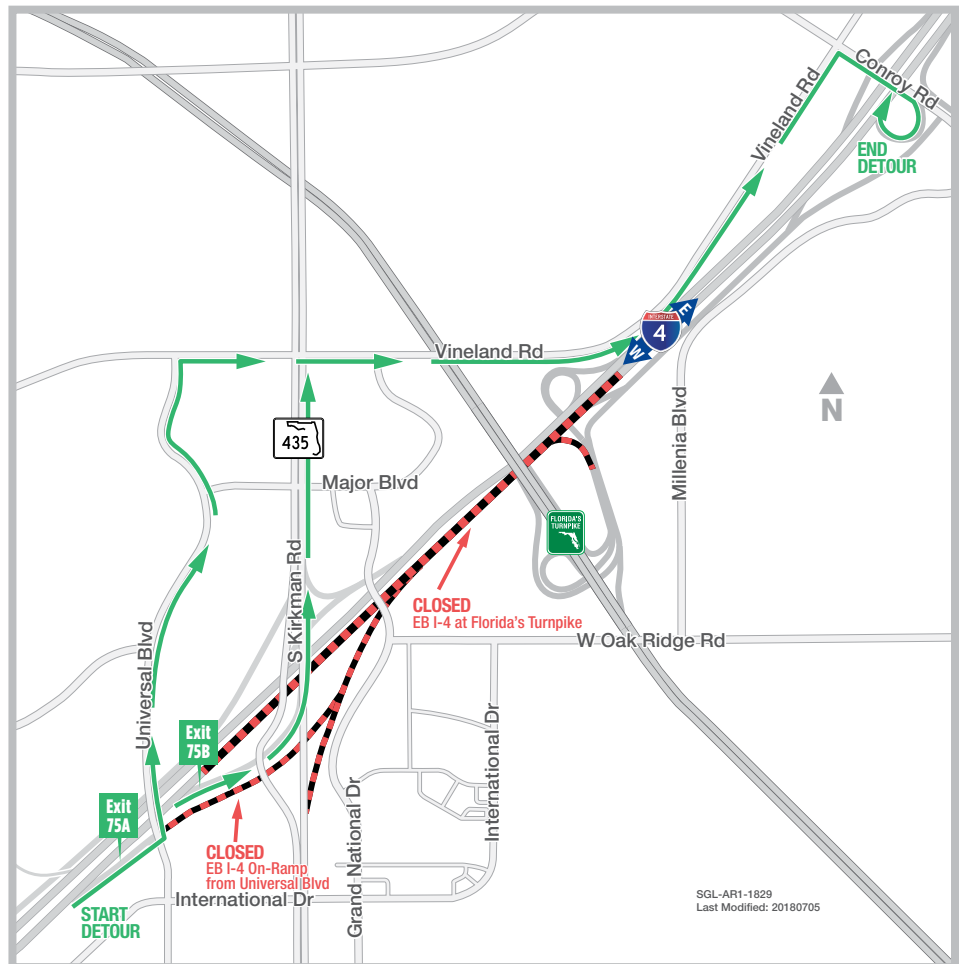
EASTBOUND I-4 BETWEEN UNIVERSAL BLVD. AND FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE CLOSING AT NIGHT ON JULY 6, 9, 10 AND 11

MULTIPLE RAMPS CLOSING AT KIRKMAN ROAD AND FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE DURING OPERATION

The Florida Department of Transportation is temporarily closing eastbound I-4 between Universal Boulevard and Florida's Turnpike from 12 a.m. until 5 a.m. on July 6, 9, 10 and 11. The eastbound I-4 exit ramp to Florida's Turnpike and entrance ramp from Kirkman Road (State Road 435) also will be closed during the same time (See reverse side for detours). The closures are necessary to safely demolish an old bridge structure at Florida's Turnpike.

Traveling eastbound on I-4 to continue on eastbound I-4:

- Use Exit 75A to Universal Boulevard
 - Turn left onto Universal Boulevard
 - Turn right onto Vineland Road
 - Turn right onto Conroy Road
 - Follow signage to re-enter eastbound I-4
- OR
- Use Exit 75B to northbound Kirkman Road
 - Turn right onto Vineland Road
 - Turn right onto Conroy Road
 - Follow signage to re-enter eastbound I-4

TWO EASTBOUND I-4 RAMPS CLOSING AT NIGHT ON JULY 6, 9, 10 AND 11

EASTBOUND I-4 EXIT RAMP TO FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE AND ON-RAMP FROM KIRKMAN ROAD CLOSING AT NIGHT

The Florida Department of Transportation is temporarily closing eastbound I-4 between Universal Boulevard and Kirkman Road (State Road 435) from 12 a.m. until 5 a.m. on July 6, 9, 10 and 11 (See reverse side for detours). During the nightly closures of eastbound I-4, the exit ramp to Florida's Turnpike and the entrance ramp from Kirkman Road will be closed from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. on the nights of July 5-6, 8-9, 9-10 and 10-11. The closures are necessary to safely demolish old Florida's Turnpike bridge structures above the interstate.

Traveling northbound on Kirkman Road to eastbound I-4:

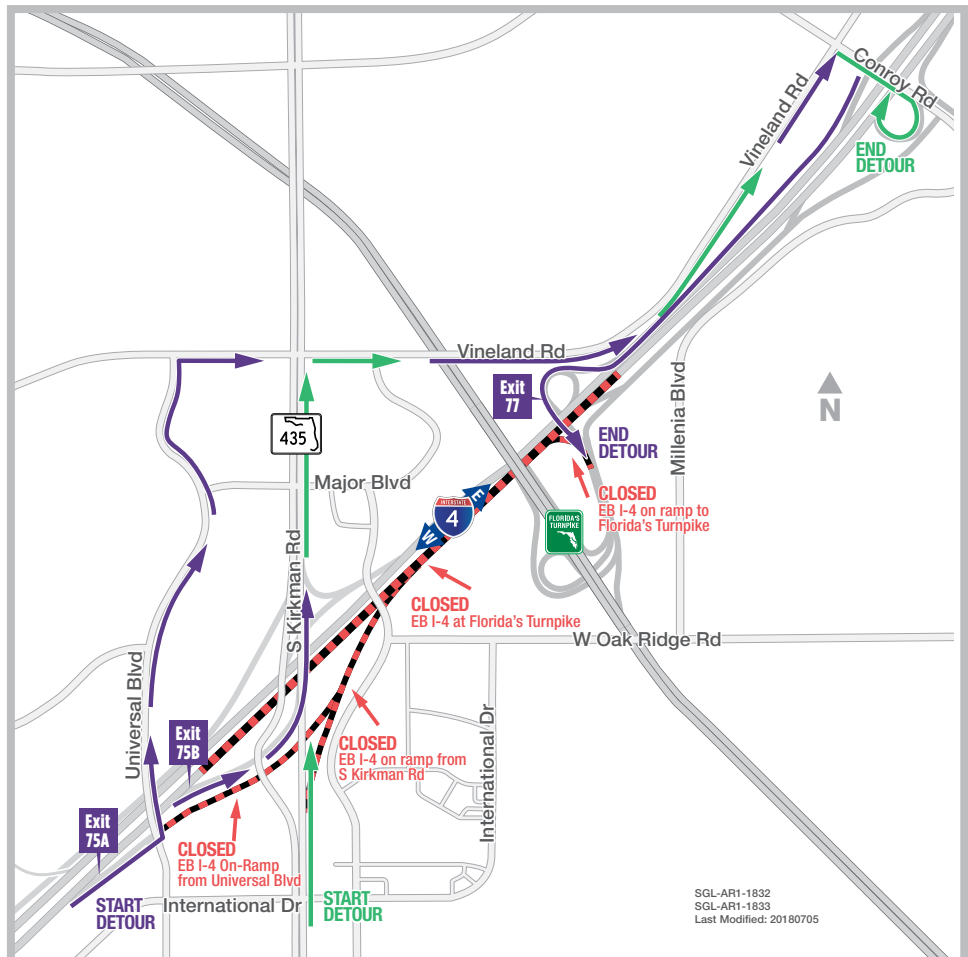
- Continue north on Kirkman Road
- Turn right onto Vineland Road
- Turn right onto Conroy Road
- Follow signage to re-enter eastbound I-4

Traveling on eastbound I-4 to Florida's Turnpike:

- Use Exit 75A to Universal Boulevard
- Turn left onto Universal Boulevard
- Turn right onto Vineland Road
- Turn right onto Conroy Road
- Follow signage to enter westbound I-4
- Use Exit 77 to Florida's Turnpike

OR

- Use Exit 75B to northbound Kirkman Road
- Turn right onto Vineland Road
- Turn right onto Conroy Road
- Follow signage to re-enter westbound I-4
- Use Exit 77 to Florida's Turnpike
