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FDOT ISSUES REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE I-4 ULTIMATE PROJECT IN ORANGE AND SEMINOLE COUNTIES

TALLAHASSEE— The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has issued a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) concerning the I-4 Ultimate project. FDOT is requesting submission of a Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) from proposers desiring to contract for the right to design, build, finance, operate and maintain the project known as the I-4 Ultimate through a Public-Private Partnership Concession Agreement.

The project includes the reconstruction of 21 miles of I-4 from west of Kirkman Road in Orange County to east of State Road 434 in Seminole County. The I-4 Ultimate project adds four tolled Express Lanes to I-4 while maintaining the existing free general use lanes, providing a choice to motorists.

FDOT is seeking a private firm that is experienced in designing, building, financing, operating and maintaining both general use and managed lane roadways. The successful proposer must have a proven ability to arrange and close financing on favorable terms, as well as demonstrated skill in managing and operating limited access roads on behalf of public sector owners.
