



Governor, legislature approve major I-4 improvement project

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. —Gov. Rick Scott and the Florida legislature have given the go-ahead to get the money for a \$2.1 billion improvement project for Interstate 4.

The project would cover 21 miles from west of Kirkman Road to east of State Road 434.

The project would include 56 new bridges and could add four managed lanes or tolled express lanes.

It would take five to six years to complete, according to the governor's office.

The Florida Department of Transportation is holding a forum in Orlando on March 4 to get private sector feedback on the project.

FDOT hopes to start the project in 2015.
