How four new toll lanes could ease I-4 traffic



The new toll lanes would cover 21 miles, from west of Kirkman Road in Orlando to Longwood, just east past State Road 434.

On Monday, about 1,200 potential investors packed the Rosen Center to learn more about ponying up cash to pay for managed toll roads along Interstate 4, [CF News 13 reports](#).

The new toll lanes cover 21 miles, from west of Kirkman Road in Orlando to Longwood, just east past State Road 434.

That, in turn, would expand I-4 to six free lanes, plus four express toll lanes, along with new ramps and 56 new bridges, including one new pedestrian crossing at Maitland Boulevard.
