State officials this week released photographs and simulated video of the \$2.1 billion makeover of **Interstate 4**, one of the most anticipated transit projects in Central Florida history.

The video shows how a 21-mile stretch of I-4 from Kirkman Road to State Road 434 will be transformed with additional lanes and improved intersections.

Four lanes – two in each direction – will be tolled, allowing motorists with transponders (and money) to avoid traffic tie-ups in the free, outside lanes.

The massive job could begin as early as 2015 and take about five years to complete.
