

New I-4 makeover team now seeking local subcontractors

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The concessionaire team responsible for tearing up and rebuilding Interstate 4 is reaching out to local subcontractors.

A spokeswoman for I-4 Mobility Partners — which the [Florida Department of Transportation](#) on April 23 named the design/build team for the \$2.3 billion I-4 Ultimate project — said now is the best opportunity for local firms to get involved.

The project involves reconstruction of 21 highway miles from west of Kirkman Road in Orange County to east of State Road 434 in Seminole County, along with the addition of four tolled express lanes.

I-4 Mobility Partners' proposal included additional technical enhancements, like direct connections from I-4 express lanes to State Road 408.

Companies interested in being part of the work are asked to visit www.I4MobilityPartners.com to register with the team.

The next step will be the financial closing, said I-4 Mobility Partners spokesman [Cesar Souza](#) after the selection meeting. That agreement should be finalized this summer and construction could begin as early as the end of this year.
