Nighttime Closure and Traffic Shift of WB I-4 Exit Ramp to S.R. 436 Set for Nov. 7

ORLANDO — The westbound Interstate 4 (I-4) exit ramp to State Road (S.R.) 436 (exit #92) is closing the night of November 7 for a traffic shift.

The S.R. 436 ramp closure is from 10 p.m. on Tuesday, November 7, until 5 a.m. on Wednesday, November 8. When the ramp reopens the morning of November 8, a new traffic shift will be in place. The shift will add a traffic signal for motorists turning right from the exit ramp onto westbound S.R. 436. Modifications or extensions to this schedule may become necessary due to weather delays or other unforeseen conditions. Motorists are advised to maintain a safe speed when driving through the work zone.

The I-4 Ultimate project is rebuilding 21 miles of Interstate 4 (I-4) from west of Kirkman Road in Orange County to east of State Road 434 in Seminole County, adding two new dynamic tolled Express Lanes in each direction, replacing more than 140 bridges, reconfiguring 15 major interchanges and reconstructing the entire roadway.
