HUGHEY AVENUE BETWEEN CHURCH STREET AND SOUTH STREET REOPENED

TWO RIGHT LANES OF HUGHEY AVENUE FROM CHURCH STREET TO SOUTH STREET ARE NOW OPEN

The Florida Department of Transportation reopened two right lanes on Hughey Avenue between Church Street and South Street on January 22. The left lane adjacent to Interstate 4 (I-4) will remain closed for construction. The reopened lanes may be subject to nightly closures for construction activities and for events at the Amway Center. Motorists traveling southbound on Hughey Avenue have restored access to the eastbound I-4 entrance ramp from South Street and the Amway Center blue lot.

The \$2.3 billion I-4 Ultimate project is reconstructing 21 miles of interstate from west of Kirkman Road to east of State Road 434 in Longwood.
