WESTBOUND I-4 ENTRANCE RAMP FROM AMELIA STREET CLOSING LONG TERM

18-MONTH CLOSURE OF THE ON-RAMP IS SCHEDULED TO BEGIN AT 5 AM ON MONDAY, MARCH 4

The Florida Department of Transportation is temporarily closing the westbound I-4 entrance ramp from Amelia Street for approximately 18 months beginning as soon as 5 a.m. on Monday, March 4. The long-term closure of the on-ramp is necessary for the construction of the new elevated westbound I-4 travel lanes through downtown Orlando.

Traveling south on Hughey Avenue to westbound I-4:

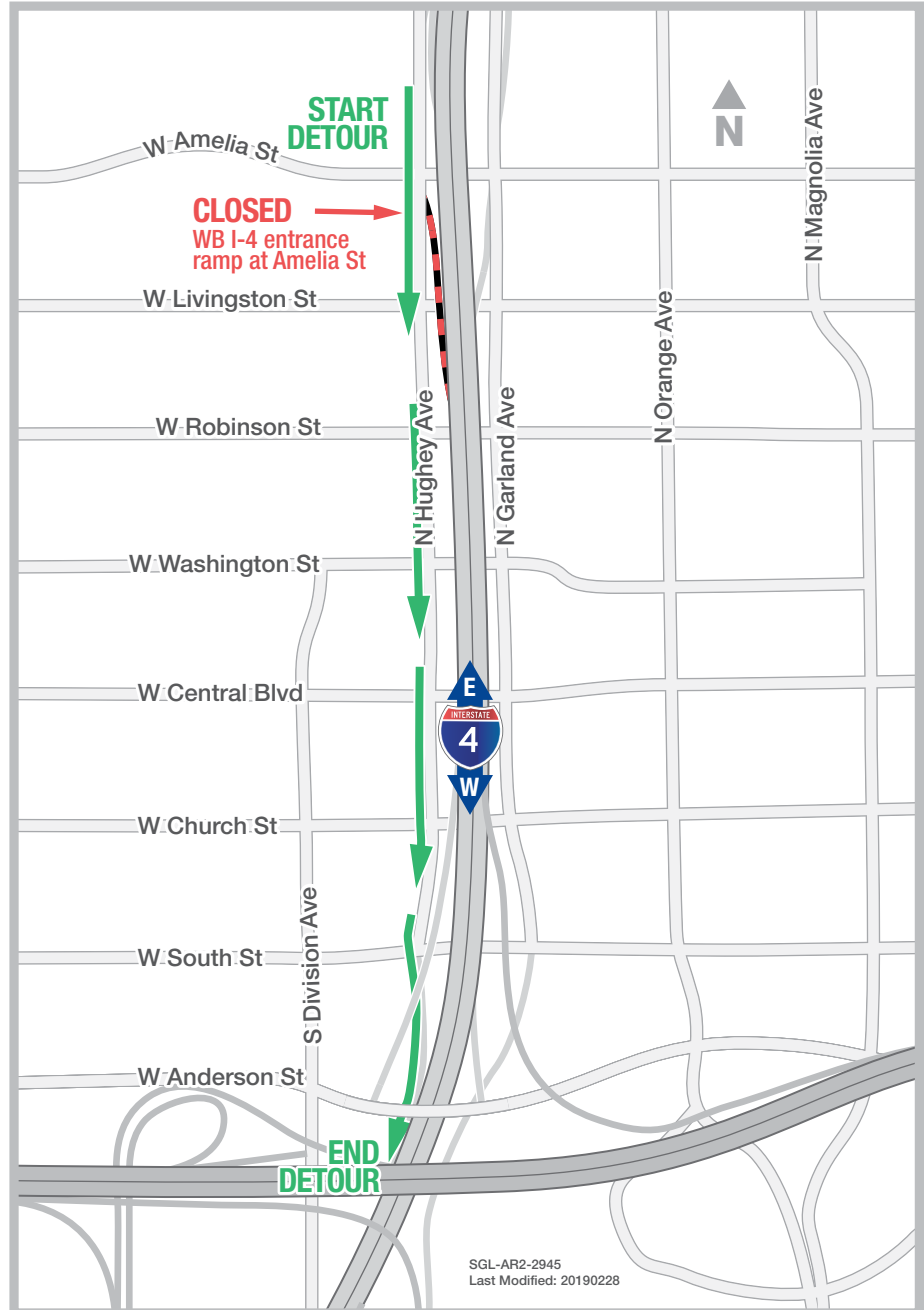
- Continue on Hughey Avenue to the westbound I-4 on-ramp at South Street
