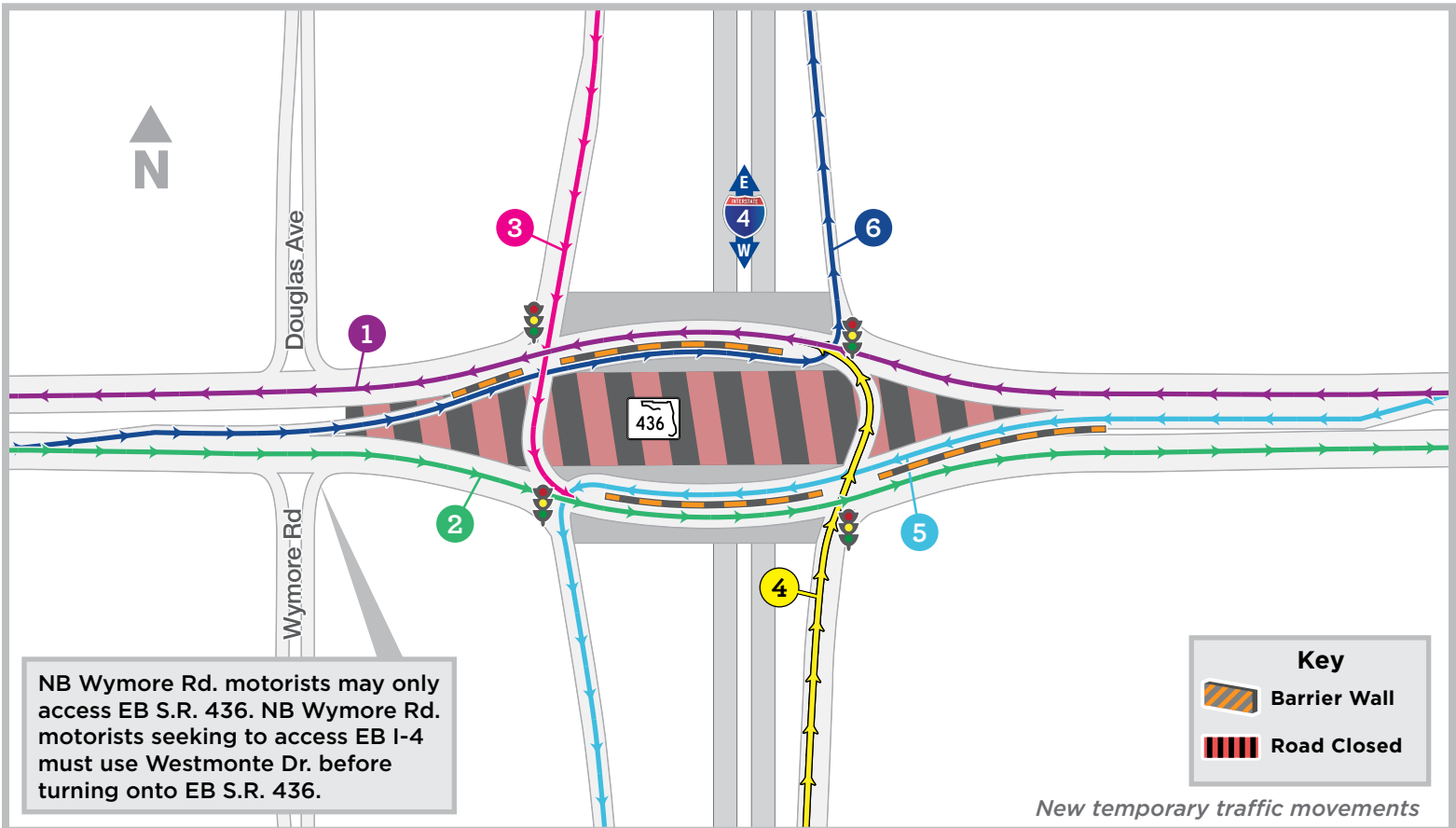
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TEMPORARY CONFIGURATION OF THE S.R. 436 AND I-4 INTERCHANGE

As soon as August 24, 2019, the State Road (S.R.) 436 interchange is undergoing a major temporary traffic shift providing work zones for crews to demolish the old S.R. 436 bridge over I-4 and continue construction on the new bridge. New traffic patterns will be introduced as part of this transformation, and motorists will use newly constructed bridge decks north and south of the old lanes. Both bridges will accommodate traffic in both directions. This interim configuration is expected to last for up to one year.
