PRINCETON STREET UNDER I-4 CLOSING WEEKEND OF FEBRUARY 21

CLOSURE SCHEDULED TO BEGIN AS SOON AS 10 P.M.

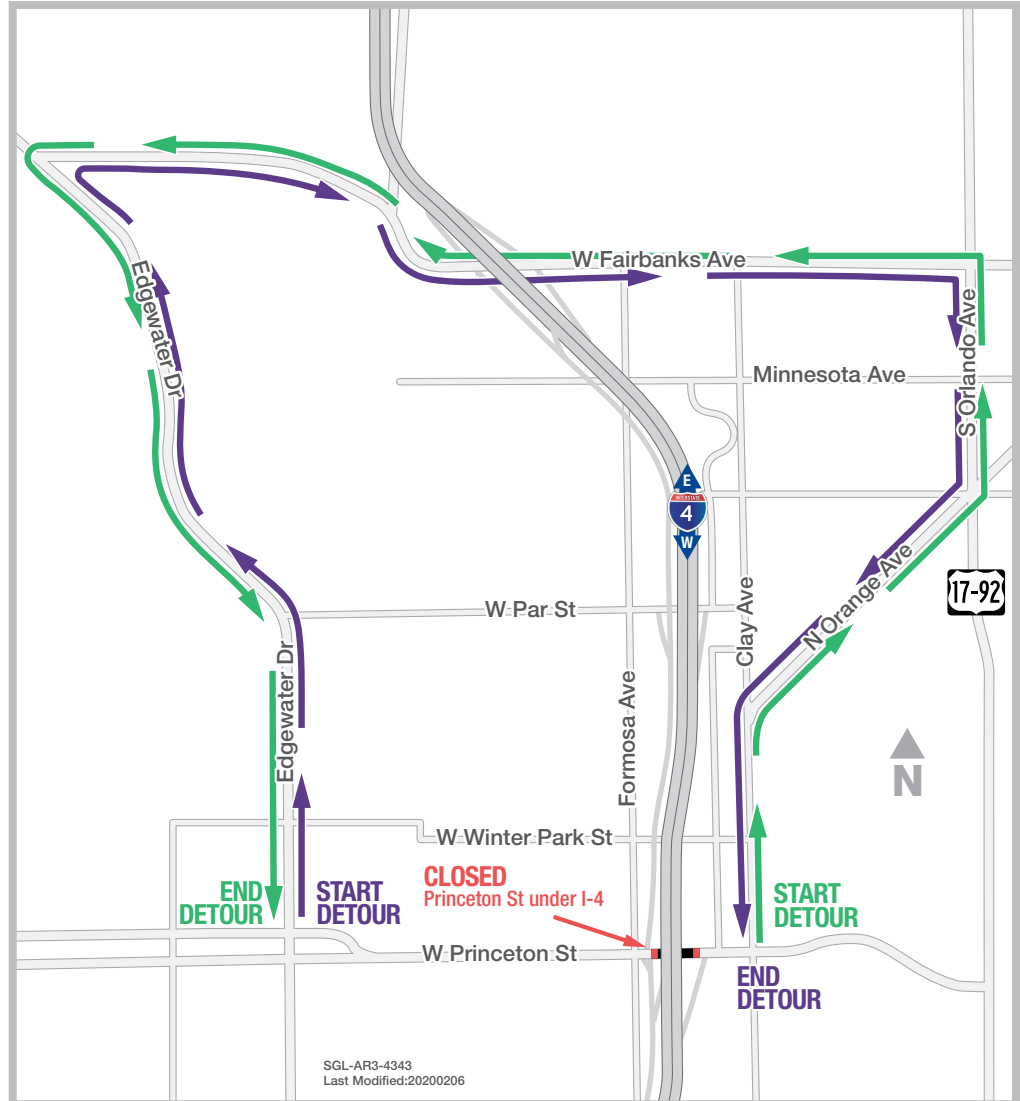
The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is temporarily closing Princeton Street under Interstate 4 (I-4) as soon as 10 p.m. Friday, February 21, and reopening it by 5 a.m. Monday, February 24. All eastbound and westbound I-4 ramps at this interchange will remain open. This closure is necessary to proceed with demolition of the old bridge over Princeton Street. Residents should anticipate extra noise and bright lights at night during these operations.

Traveling on Princeton Street east of I-4:

- Travel north on Orange Avenue
- At the intersection with Clay Avenue, keep right onto Orange Avenue
- Turn left onto Orlando Avenue (U.S. 17-92)
- Turn left onto Fairbanks Avenue
- Turn left onto Edgewater Drive

Traveling on Princeton Street west of I-4:

- Travel north on Edgewater Drive
- Turn right onto Fairbanks Avenue
- Turn right onto Orlando Avenue
- Turn right onto Orange Avenue
- At the intersection with Clay Avenue, continue on Orange Avenue

The \$2.3 billion I-4 Ultimate project is reconstructing 21 miles of interstate from west of Kirkman Road to east of State Road 434 in Longwood.
