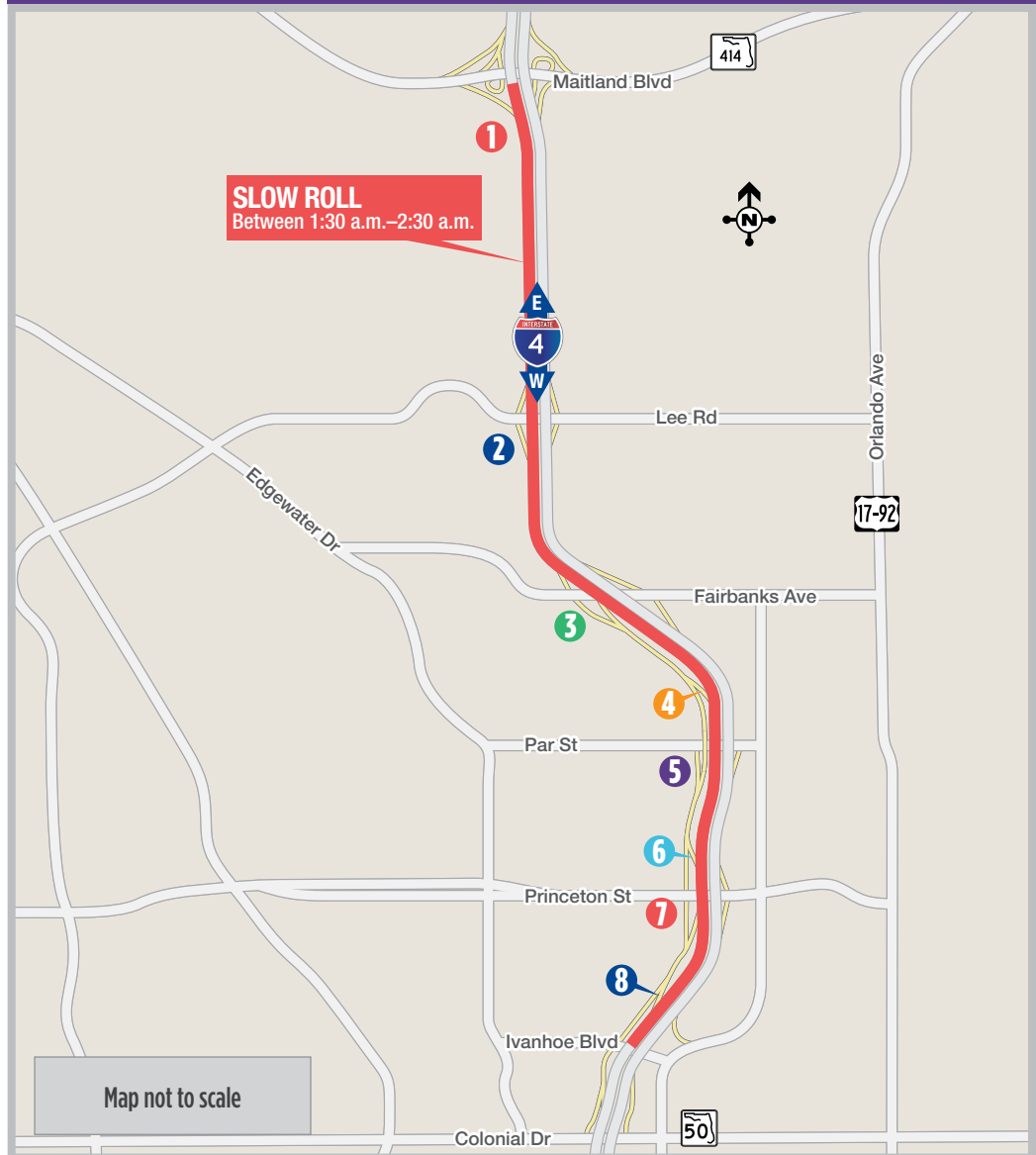
WB I-4 TRAFFIC PACING OPERATION SCHEDULED BETWEEN MAITLAND BOULEVARD AND PRINCETON STREET

A traffic pacing operation is scheduled to occur between 1:30 a.m. and 2:30 a.m. the morning of Wednesday, October 9, on westbound Interstate 4 (I-4) from Maitland Boulevard (State Road 414) to Princeton Street. During the operation, westbound I-4 entrance ramps between these limits will be temporarily blocked by law enforcement officers to ensure no vehicles jump ahead of the traffic pacing operation. As the pace car passes each interchange, the corresponding entrance ramp onto westbound I-4 will be reopened to allow motorists to enter and join the slow roll. The traffic pacing operation and temporary ramp closures will create a 30-minute window for crews to move equipment and remove an existing overhead truss located just south of Princeton Street.
