I-4 WB ENTRANCE RAMP FROM COLONIAL DRIVE TEMPORARILY CLOSING FOR SIX MONTHS

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is temporarily closing the Interstate 4 (I-4) westbound entrance ramp from Colonial Drive as soon as Sunday, February 2 at 10 p.m. After the ramp closes, drivers will need to continue south on Hughey Avenue and enter westbound I-4 from the South Street on ramp.

To accommodate additional traffic, a third lane of southbound Hughey Avenue will open between Colonial Drive and South Street. The middle and right lanes of Hughey Avenue at the intersection with South Street will provide access to the westbound I-4 on ramp.

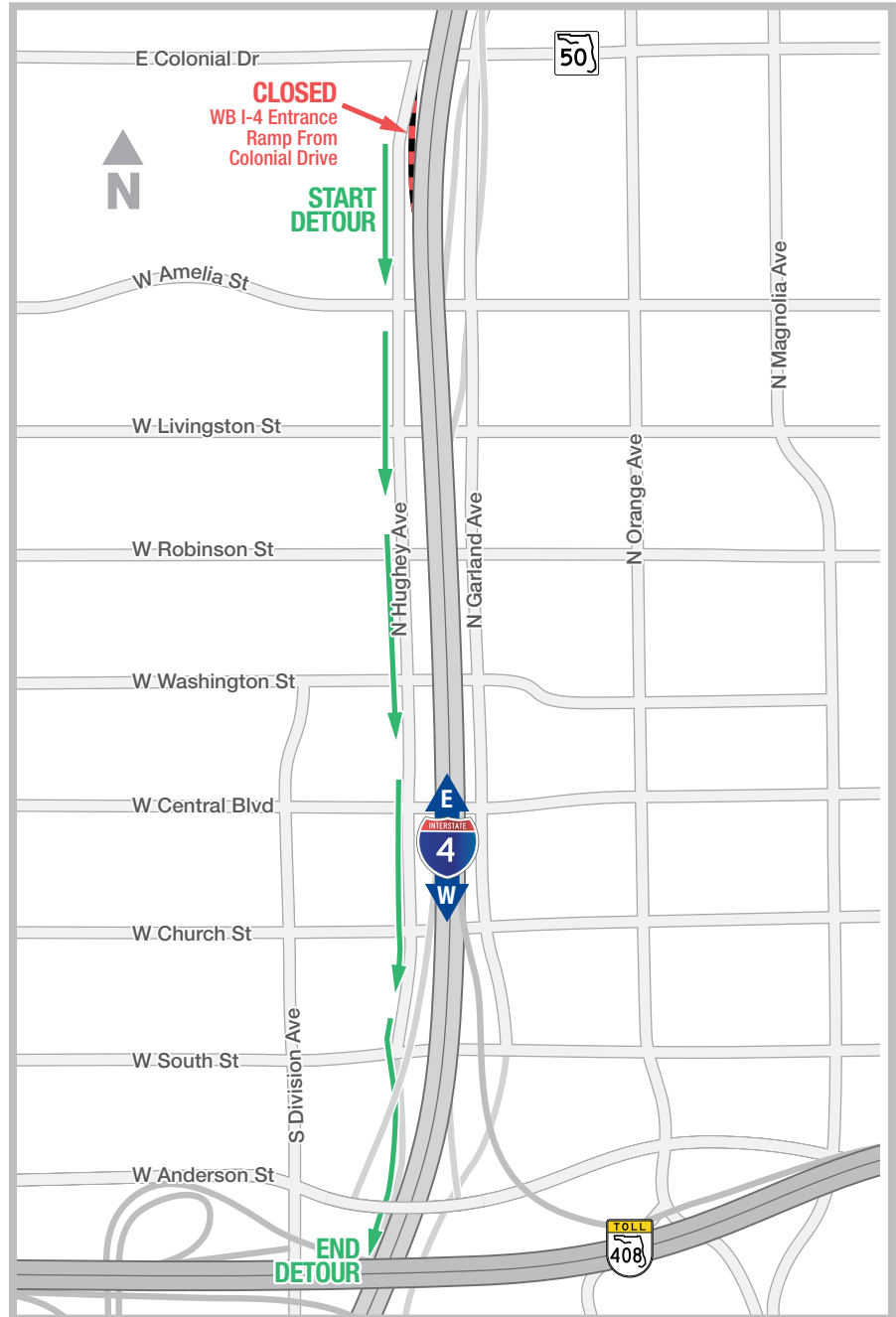
The closure is necessary to allow crews to safely construct the new permanent westbound I-4 lanes through Downtown Orlando. The ramp will reopen in approximately six months.

Entering westbound I-4 from Colonial Drive:

- Continue on Hughey Avenue
- Follow signs to westbound I-4
