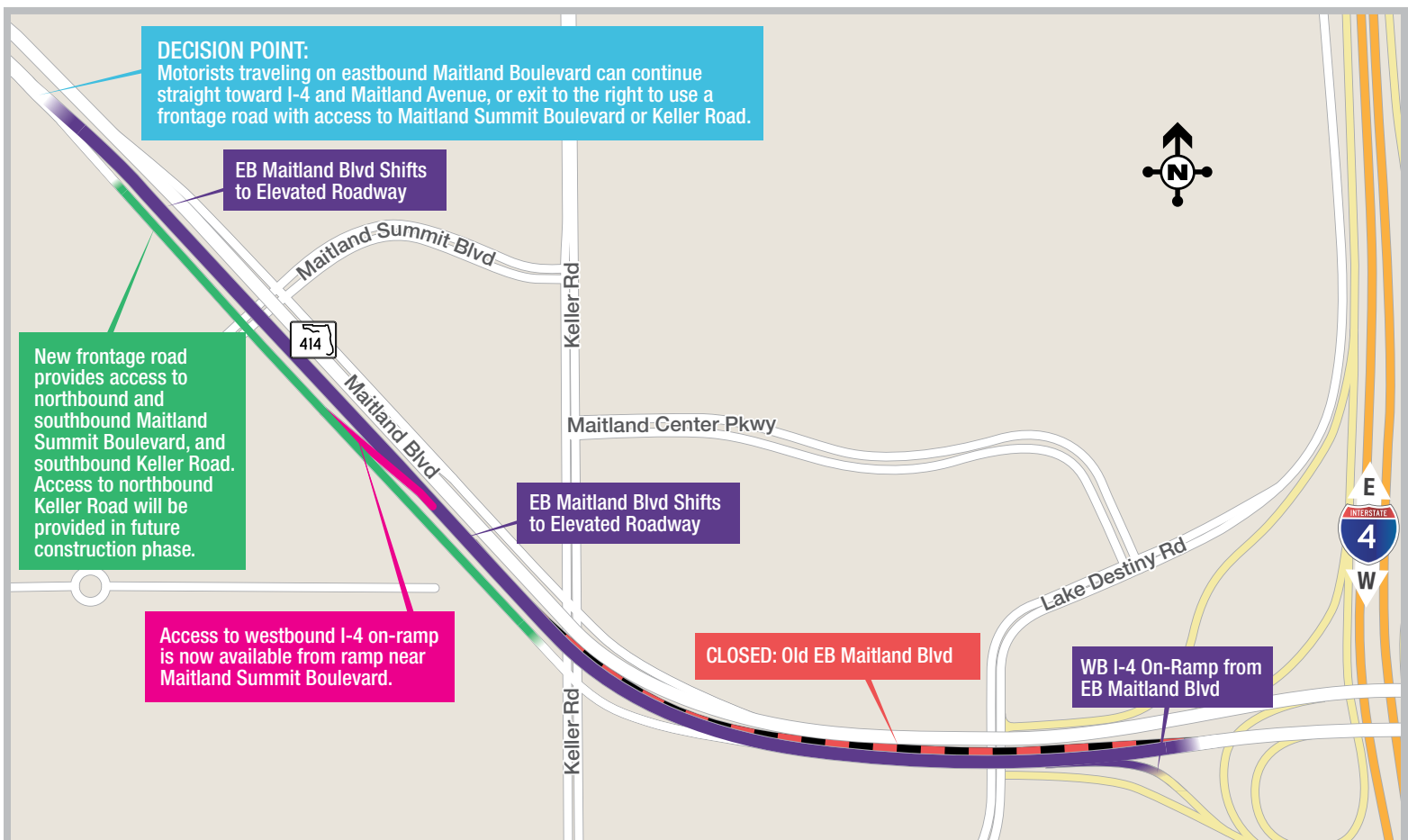

EB MAITLAND BOULEVARD BETWEEN MAITLAND SUMMIT BOULEVARD AND WB I-4 ENTRANCE RAMP SHIFTING TO PERMANENT CONFIGURATION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is shifting eastbound Maitland Boulevard (State Road 414) lanes onto new flyover bridges between Maitland Summit Boulevard to the westbound Interstate 4 (I-4) entrance ramp early Tuesday morning, February 4.

This shift relocates traffic onto nearly two miles of newly paved roadway and adds an additional lane to increase capacity to help reduce backups. As part of this movement, eastbound Maitland Boulevard will allow free-flow traffic starting at State Road 434 to the I-4 access ramps.

To accommodate the shift, FDOT will temporarily close lanes along eastbound Maitland Boulevard between Maitland Summit Boulevard and Lake Destiny Road. The lane closures are scheduled to begin as soon as 9 p.m. Monday, February 3. All the new elevated lanes are expected to be open to traffic by 5:30 a.m. Tuesday morning.
