



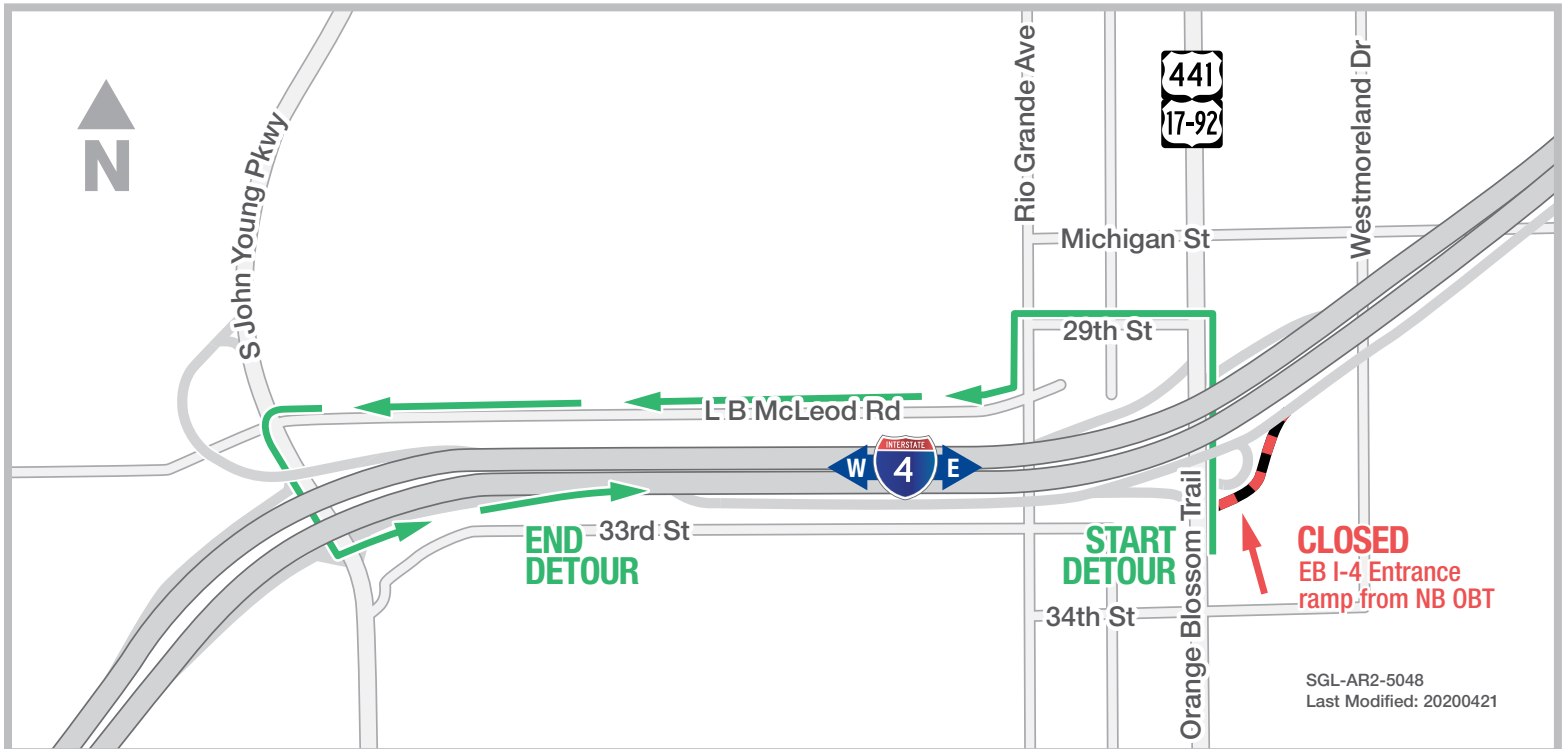

I-4 EASTBOUND ENTRANCE RAMP FROM ORANGE BLOSSOM TRAIL CLOSING FOR ONE MONTH

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is closing the eastbound Interstate 4 (I-4) entrance ramp from northbound Orange Blossom Trail (U.S. 441/17-92) for approximately one month. The continuous closure is scheduled to start as soon as 5 a.m. Monday, April 27, and end by 5 a.m. Friday, May 29. The closure is necessary to allow crews to construct a new ramp and accelerate interchange construction by 1-2 months.



Traveling northbound on Orange Blossom Trail:

- Continue north on Orange Blossom Trail
- Turn left onto 29th Street
- Turn left onto Rio Grande Avenue
- Turn right onto LB McLeod Road
- Turn left onto John Young Parkway
- Follow signs to eastbound I-4

The \$2.3 billion I-4 Ultimate project is reconstructing 21 miles of interstate from west of Kirkman Road to east of State Road 434 in Longwood.
