WB I-4 ENTRANCE FROM IVANHOE BLVD CLOSING FOR ONE MONTH

CLOSURE SCHEDULED TO BEGIN AS SOON AS APRIL 24

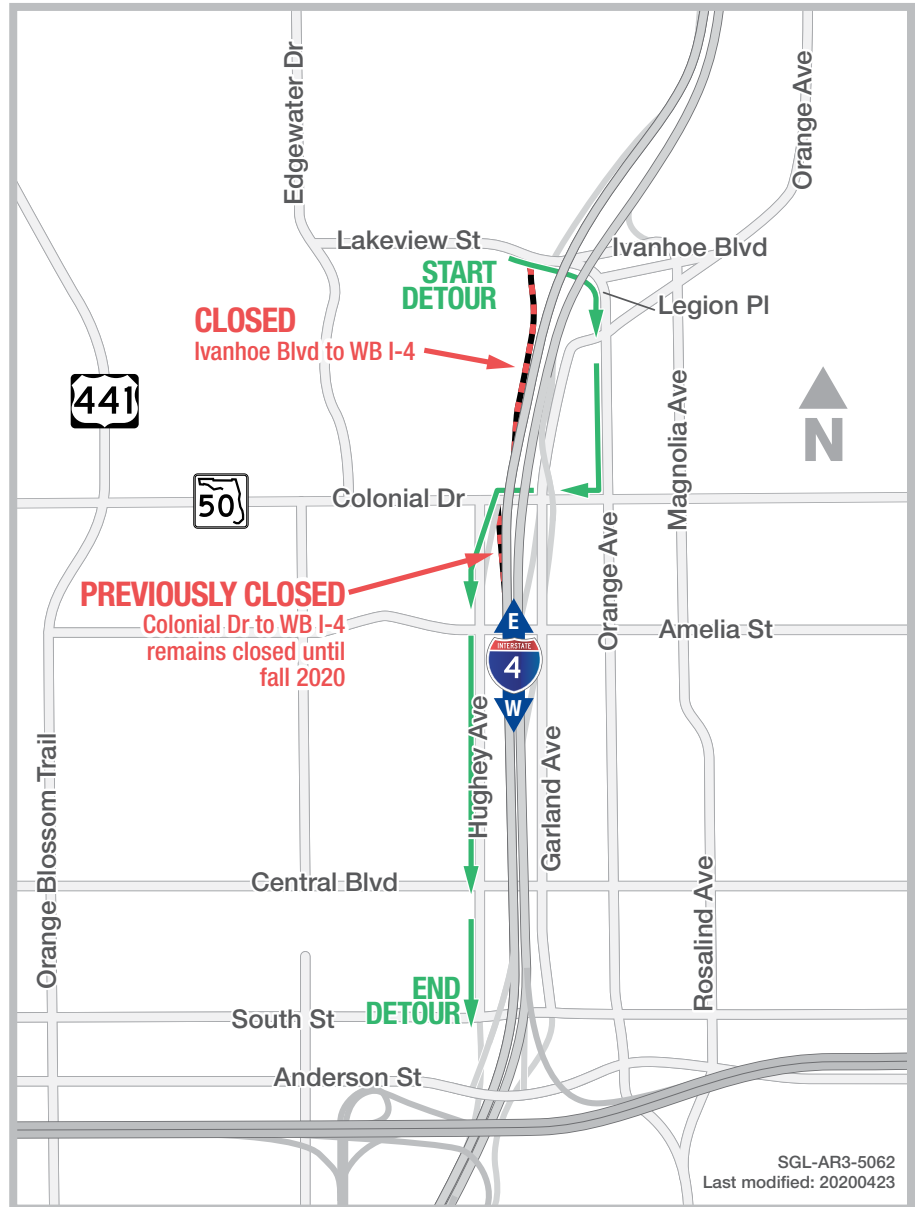
The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is temporarily closing the westbound Interstate 4 (I-4) entrance ramp from Ivanhoe Boulevard as soon as 5 a.m. Friday, April 24. The ramp is scheduled to reopen in approximately one month. The continuous closure provides space for crews to construct new westbound I-4 travel lanes and permanent interstate ramps between Ivanhoe Boulevard and Colonial Drive (State Road 50).

Accessing westbound I-4 from Ivanhoe Boulevard:

- Continue east on Ivanhoe Boulevard
- Turn right onto Legion Place/ Orange Avenue
- Turn right onto Colonial Drive
- Turn left onto Hughey Avenue
- Follow signs to westbound I-4 from South Street

The \$2.3 billion I-4 Ultimate project is reconstructing 21 miles of interstate from west of Kirkman Road to east of State Road 434 in Longwood.
