EB I-4 LANES FROM KALEY AVENUE TO ORANGE BLOSSOM TRAIL SHIFTING

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is shifting the eastbound Interstate 4 (I-4) ramp system between Orange Blossom Trail (US-441/17-92) and Kaley Avenue onto newly constructed general use lanes as soon as Friday, June 19.

After the shift, the decision point of the ramp system will shift approximately 1,000 feet sooner. This is just after the ramp passes over Rio Grande Avenue. Motorist can keep right to exit to Orange Blossom Trail (Exit 80 AB) and stay left continue to the exit to Kaley Avenue (Exit 81).

Motorists entering eastbound I-4 from northbound Orange Blossom Trail will follow the ramp system for nearly one mile and enter the interstate after crossing Michigan Street.
