



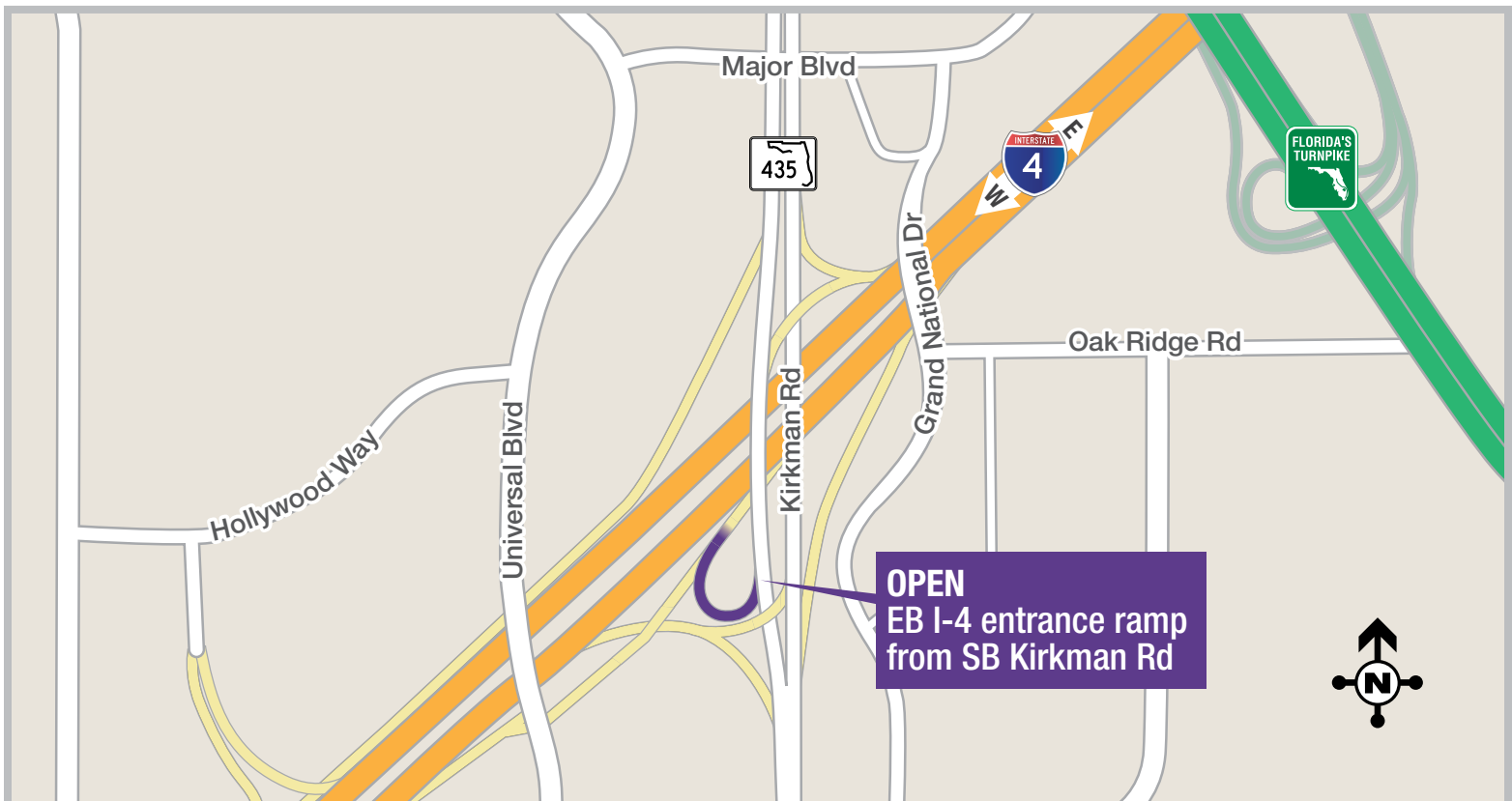

NEW EASTBOUND I-4 ENTRANCE RAMP FROM SOUTHBOUND KIRKMAN ROAD OPENING

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is opening a new entrance ramp to eastbound Interstate 4 (I-4) from southbound Kirkman Road as soon as the morning of Wednesday, September 30. The new movement, which didn't exist before the I-4 Ultimate project, is the last ramp to move into its final configuration, completing road work at the interchange. Drivers will need to be in the right lane as they pass over I-4 to enter the free-flowing single lane ramp from the right side of southbound Kirkman Road.



PROJECT INFO

The \$2.3 billion I-4 Ultimate project is reconstructing 21 miles of interstate from west of Kirkman Road to east of State Road 434 in Longwood.
