I-4 ENTRANCE RAMP FROM MICHIGAN STREET OPENING IN FINAL FOOTPRINT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is opening the eastbound Interstate 4 (I-4) entrance ramp from Michigan Street as soon as 11 a.m. Saturday, October 10. The ramp was closed in February to allow crews to construct a new ramp. When the new ramp opens, the eastbound I-4 entrance ramp from Kaley Avenue will close permanently.

As part of the reconstruction of I-4, the ramps at Michigan Street and Kaley Avenue will be braided over each other to eliminate crossover points and weaving traffic patterns. Additionally, Texas U-turns under Michigan Street and Kaley Avenue will be constructed and scheduled to open in December 2020.

The \$2.3 billion I-4 Ultimate project is reconstructing 21 miles of interstate from west of Kirkman Road to east of State Road 434 in Longwood.
