



BUILDING A BETTER I-4

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WESTBOUND I-4 TRAFFIC PACING OPERATION SCHEDULED FROM H.E. THOMAS JR. PARKWAY TO THE WESTBOUND I-4 REST AREA

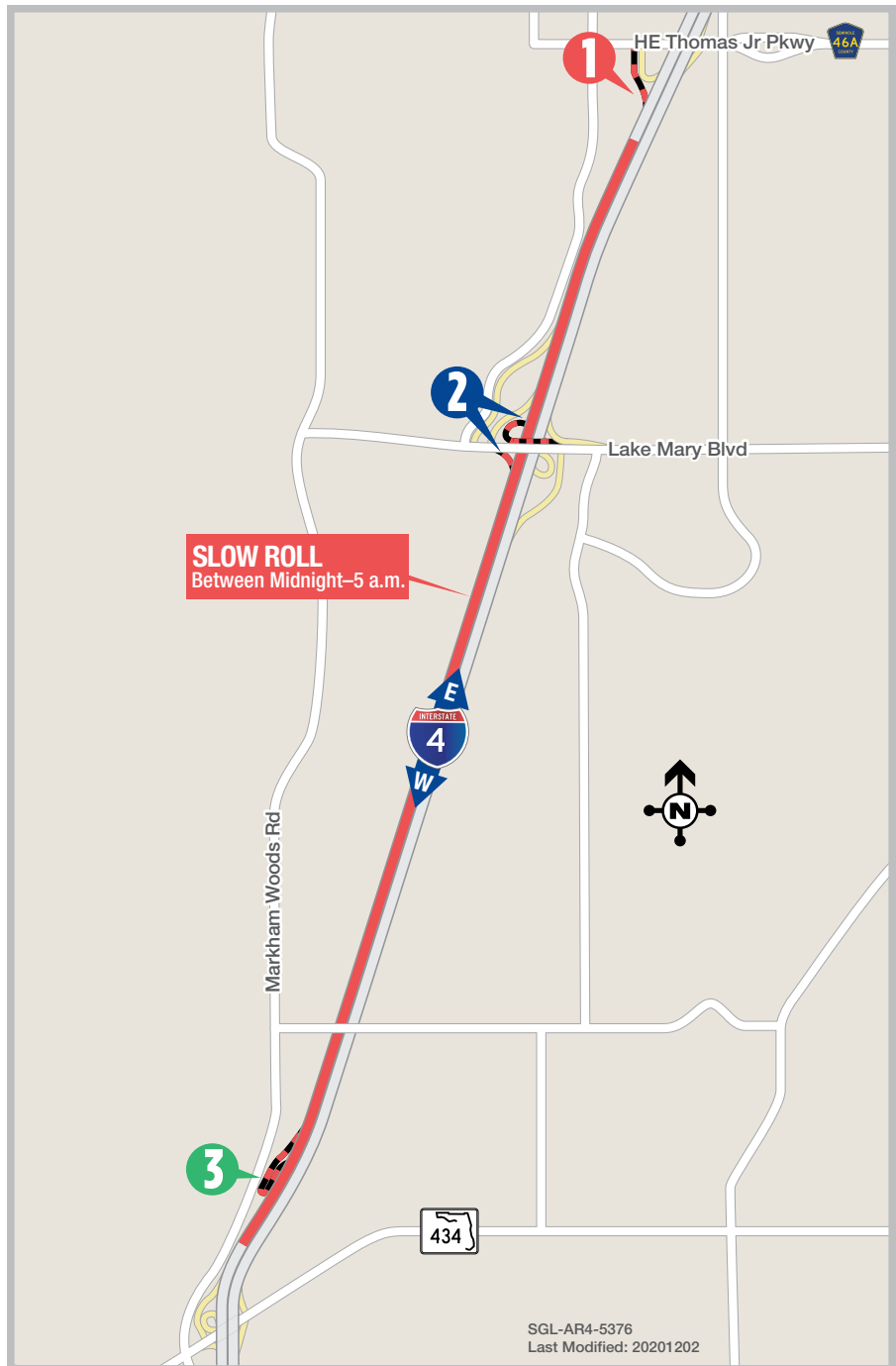
A traffic pacing operation is scheduled to occur between midnight and 5 a.m. the morning of Friday, December 4, on westbound Interstate 4 (I-4) from H.E. Thomas Jr. Parkway to the westbound I-4 rest area. During the operation, westbound I-4 entrance ramps between these limits will be temporarily blocked by law enforcement officers to ensure no vehicles jump ahead of the traffic pacing operation. As the pace car passes each interchange, the corresponding entrance ramp onto westbound I-4 will be reopened to allow motorist to enter and join the slow roll. The traffic pacing operation and temporary ramp closures will create a 30-minute window for crews to install an overhead sign truss.
