EB I-4 TRAFFIC PACING OPERATION SCHEDULED BETWEEN FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE AND MICHIGAN STREET

A traffic pacing operation is scheduled to occur between midnight and 5 a.m. the morning of Saturday, January 30, on eastbound Interstate 4 (I-4) from Florida's Turnpike to Michigan Street. During the operation, eastbound I-4 entrance ramps between these limits will be temporarily blocked by law enforcement officers to ensure no vehicles jump ahead of the traffic pacing operation. As the pace car passes each interchange, the corresponding entrance ramp onto eastbound I-4 will be reopened to allow motorists to enter and join the slow roll. The traffic pacing operation and temporary ramp closures will create a 30-minute window for crews to install an overhead sign truss.
