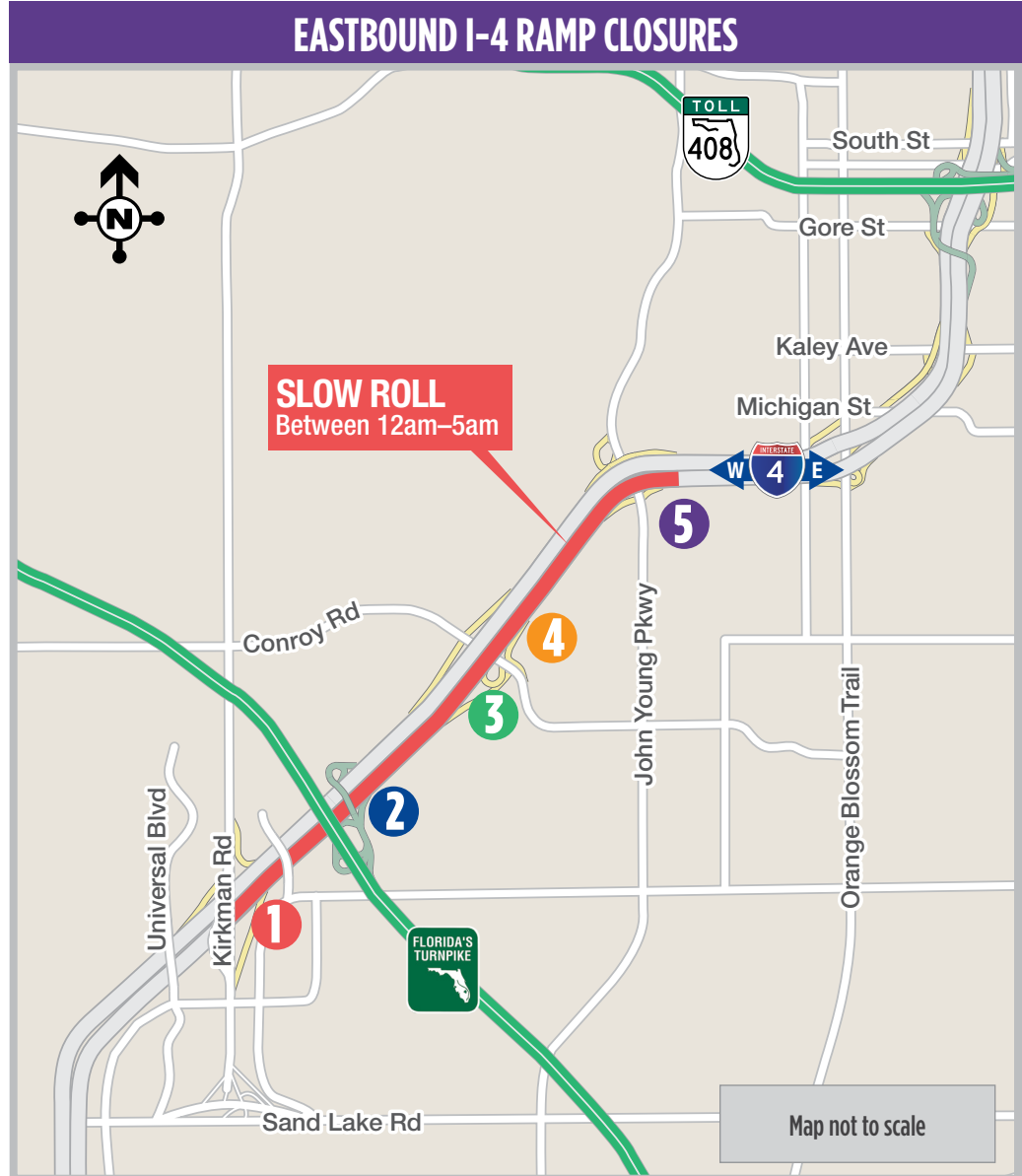

EASTBOUND I-4 TRAFFIC PACING OPERATION FROM KIRKMAN ROAD TO ORANGE BLOSSOM TRAIL

A traffic pacing operation on eastbound Interstate 4 (I-4) from Kirkman Road to Orange Blossom Trail (US 17-92/441) is scheduled between 12 a.m. and 5 a.m. on December 19. During the traffic pacing operation, eastbound I-4 on-ramps will be temporary blocked by law enforcement officers to ensure no vehicles jump ahead of the traffic pacing operation. As the pace car passes an interchange, its eastbound I-4 entrance ramp will be reopened allowing motorists to enter and join the slow roll. The traffic pacing operation and temporary closures of eastbound I-4 entrance ramps will create a 30-minute window for crews to remove an old overhead sign structure. Public safety vehicles are permitted to skip past the traffic pacing operation to respond to an emergency call.
