EASTBOUND I-4 BETWEEN LEE ROAD AND MAITLAND BOULEVARD CLOSING EARLY MORNING JULY 23 AND 30

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to temporarily close eastbound Interstate 4 (I-4) between Lee Road and Maitland Boulevard (State Road 414) from midnight to 4 a.m. on Friday, July 23 and Friday, July 30.

The eastbound I-4 entrance ramp from Lee Road and the eastbound I-4 exit ramps to Maitland Boulevard and Sandspur Road will be closed at the same time. The closures require I-4 motorists to detour off the interstate for safety while crews install an overhead sign.

Traveling on eastbound I-4 to Maitland Boulevard:

- Take Exit 88 to Lee Road and turn left
- Turn right onto Edgewater Drive
- Turn right onto S.R. 434
- Follow signage to Maitland Boulevard

Traveling on eastbound I-4:

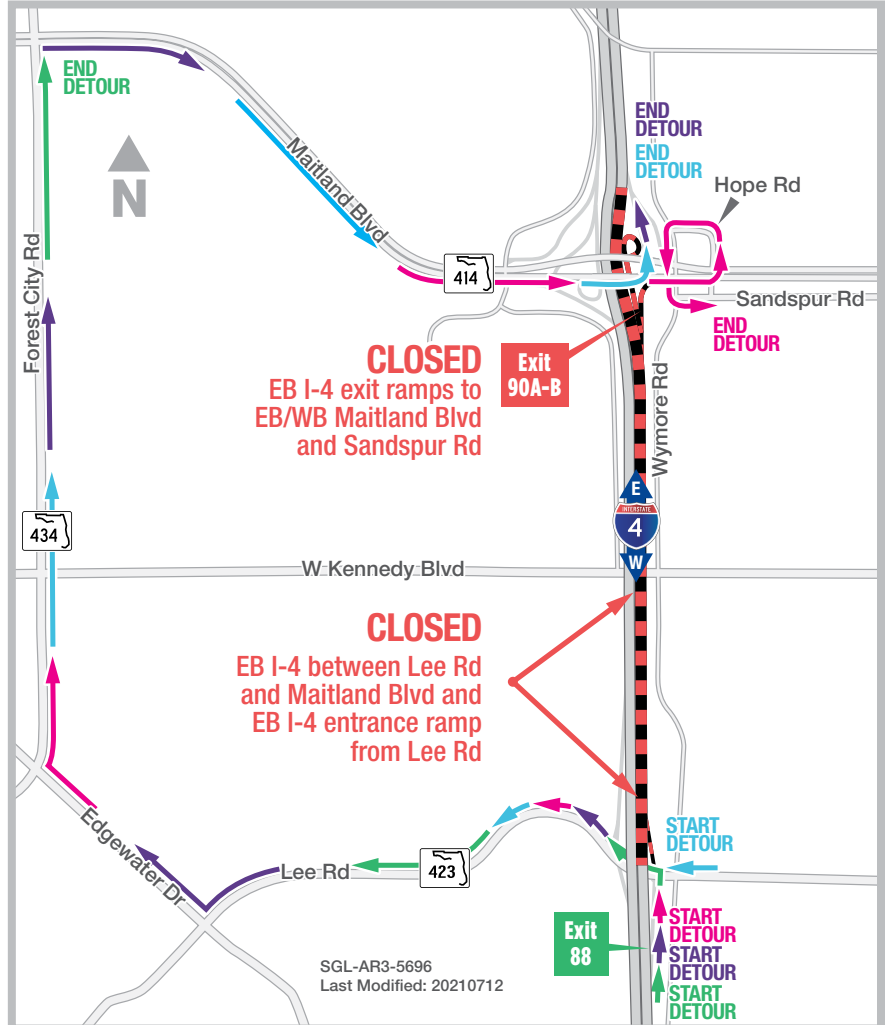
- Follow green detour to Maitland Boulevard
- Follow signage to EB I-4

Traveling on Lee Road to eastbound I-4:

- Follow green detour to Maitland Boulevard
- Follow signage to EB I-4

Traveling on eastbound I-4 to Sandspur Road:

- Follow green detour to Maitland Boulevard
- Turn left onto Hope Road
- Turn left onto Wymore Road
- Turn left onto Sandspur Road

The \$2.3 billion I-4 Ultimate project is reconstructing 21 miles of interstate from west of Kirkman Road to east of State Road 434 in Longwood.
