POTENTIAL JOB OPPORTUNITIES WORKSHOP

Interstate 4 (I-4) is undergoing major reconstruction in Central Florida, and with that comes opportunity. I-4 will be completely transformed along the 21 miles that stretch from Kirkman Road to State Road 434. The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be creating a new look and feel on I-4. Some of the improvements will include new Express Lanes, reconstructed interchanges and many completely rebuilt bridges.

Labor and Skilled Craft Positions


