**EB I-4 Exit Ramp to South Street Closing the Weekend of October 25**  
*Closure scheduled to begin as soon as 10 p.m. on Friday and end by 5 a.m. on Monday*

Orlando, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is temporarily closing the eastbound Interstate 4 (I-4) ramp to South St. (Exit 82B) as soon as 10 p.m. on Friday, October 25, and reopening it by 5 a.m. on Monday, October 28.

The continuous weekend closure is necessary for bridge work.

The detour for this closure is to take the shared ramps to Orange Blossom Trail (U.S. 441/17-92) and Kaley Avenue (Exit 80), stay left to continue to the Kaley Avenue exit ramp, at the end of the ramp, turn right onto Kaley Avenue, turn left onto Orange Avenue and continue to South Street.
