Traffic Advisory: EB I-4 from Lee Rd to Maitland Blvd Closing for One Night

MAITLAND, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will temporarily close eastbound Interstate 4 (I-4) from Lee Road to Maitland Boulevard (State Road 414) for one night.

The closure is scheduled to occur as soon as 11:30 p.m. Sunday, November 29 at and end by 6 a.m. Monday, November 30.

During these closures, the eastbound I-4 entrance ramp from Lee Road and the eastbound I-4 exit ramps to Maitland Boulevard will also be closed.
