Traffic Advisory: Westbound I-4 entrance ramps from Maitland Boulevard Closing for One Weekend

MAITLAND, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will temporarily close the westbound Interstate 4 (I-4) entrance ramps from eastbound and westbound Maitland Boulevard (State Road 414) and Lake Destiny Road for one weekend, beginning Friday, October 30.

The three-day closure will begin as soon as 10 p.m. Friday, October 30, and will reopen as soon as 5 a.m. Monday, November 2. Please view or download [this handout](#) for further details about the closure and detour.

One right lane on westbound I-4 through the Maitland Boulevard Interchange will also close from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday, October 31.

The closure is necessary for construction of the Maitland pedestrian bridge. Additional closures in this area are expected during construction. Please visit the Maitland pedestrian bridge [web page](#) to learn more.
